



# Herckenrath family details

My thanks to the researches of Eduard Driessen and others whose online resources have assisted me in filling out much of this information.

Arthur Frederick Monnier Harper's wife was Anna Maria Françoise Louise Herckenrath, apparently known as Anny.

Anny's father was Leonardus Johannes Paulus Herckenrath (10 May 1835 – 19 November 1894).

He was born in Amsterdam, the eleventh of the twelve children of Ludovicus Joannes Herckenrath ([chr] 19 May 1792 – 28 September 1876) and Susanna Cornelia Bernardina Josepha van Erven Dorens ([chr] 11 November 1808 – 21 December 1874).

Leonardus Johannes Paulus Herckenrath was twice-married:

- (i) 14 May 1867 at Amsterdam  
Sophia Paulina Maria Adriana de Vois (08 August 1842 – 13 March 1875)  
(only one daughter lived into old age, Maria Adriana Josepha Herckenrath (1870-1957))
- (ii) 12 October 1881 at Dordrecht  
Anna Maria van Kuyk [or Kuijk] (10 October 1859-1939)  
(one son and three daughters survived into old age)

One of those daughters from the second marriage was Anny: Anna Maria Françoise Louise Herckenrath, born 11 October 1883 in Apeldoorn in the Netherlands.

Her siblings were \*Léonie Françoise Marie Herckenrath, born 8 April 1888, died 11 October 1961

\*She's also recorded as Françoise Léonie Marie Herckenrath

Léonie Susanna Waltera Maria Herckenrath, born 28 February 1890, died 1976

Leonardus Carolus Johan Jules Marie Herckenrath,

born 06 March 1894, died 1976

Anny married Arthur Frederick Monnier Harper on 10 April 1905 in Brussels.

They had one child, a daughter, Lygia Monnier Harper.

The couple divorced on 16 July 1915 in 's-Gravenhage [The Hague], when Monnier Harper was seriously ill and half paralysed. Monnier Harper died on 02 January 1916.

**VOLSTREKT EENIGE KENNISGEVING.**

Anny died in Lawang (East-Java) aged 58 or 59 (c.1941), probably around the same time as her mother-in-law in Cannes. It's strange that she's not listed amongst the family in the death notice above. (Regrettably I seem to have mislaid my source for this dating of Anny's death.)

Anny was survived by her daughter Mrs Lygia Klasing-Harper, living in Tjolomadoe, [Surakarta], Java, Dutch East Indies, and Lygia's two children – Lygia and Henk.
